## 1. Introduction

This guide provides direction for the installation of the PUREGAS PVDW31 Interface Kit. It will cover the procedures for installing a new interface kit into PUREGAS P4200W, P6500W, P10/15KW, and P20/30KW Air Dryers.

This guide will be used during the installation of the Puregas P011988 Kit.

**Note:** For dryers manufactured before June 1, 2010 please contact Puregas LLC for an upgraded microprocessor. This will allow the remote reset.

Troubleshooting and maintenance procedures go beyond the scope of this guide and will not be covered.




## 5. Installation for a P4200W


1. Power the dryer OFF.



2. Release the latch and open the front panel.



3. Remove the plastic plug from the top of the unit.





4. Install the PVDW31 interface module onto the top of the P4200W as shown.


5. Install strain relief around interface cable and route cable into the unit. Install strain relief into hole. Attach the other end of the interface cable to the PVDW31 Ty-rap as needed.

6. Route the interface cable through the inside of the unit following the current routing of wires. Use Ty-raps as needed.

7. Install interface cable onto W2 on the control board.











8. Install DANGER decal onto front panel as shown.





## 6. Installation for a P6500W


1. Power the dryer OFF.




2. Release both side latches and remove the top panel.



3. Install PVDW31 interface module onto the back of the unit as shown.




4. Install and route the interface cable as shown.






## 7 Installation for a P10/15KW


1. Power the unit off.



2. Release both side latches and remove the top panel.






## 8. Installation for a P20/30KW


1. Power the dryer Off.



2. Install PVDW31 interface module onto the back of the front panel as shown.




3. Attach the end of the interface cable to the PVDW31 Ty-rap as needed. Route as shown.




