

- Cutters or Snips


4. Included Contents

5. Installation for a P550W


1. Power the dryer OFF.




2. Remove front panel.




- 3. Locate the 25' DB9 cable and the cable markers. Label both sides of the cable with the desired marker number

- 5. Remove current snap bushing.
- 6. Route the small cable end through the unit. (Ty-rap as needed)
- 7. Install split snap bushing.




- 8. Connect the cable to the DB-9 connection on the control board.
- 9. Re-connect the cable.
- 10. Route the other end to the P08033W Cycle Module, but do not connect to the cycle module. (See cycle kit installation guide).



6. Installation for a P1500W


1. Power the dryer OFF.




2. Remove front panel.




- 3. Locate the 25' DB9 cable and the cable markers. Label both sides of the cable with the desired marker number

- 7. Install split snap bushing.




- 8. Connect the cable to the DB-9 connection on the control board.

7. Installation for a P4200W

- 4. Route the other end to the P08033W Cycle Module, but do not connect to the cycle module. (See cycle kit installation guide).
- 5. Power the dryer ON.
